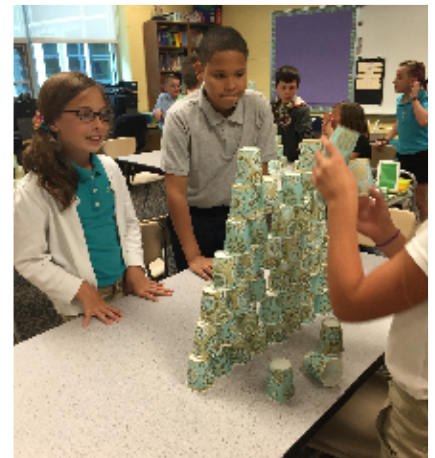
OFF TO A GREAT START!

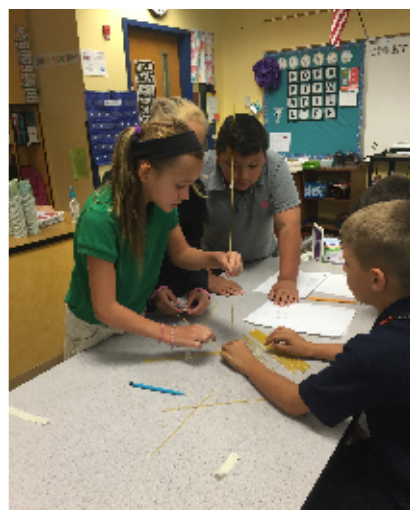

Many students found that when adding the weight of the marshmallow the tower wasn't able to stand. Even though we didn't have a table that successfully completed the challenge, students learned many things from this activity. Teamwork, compromise, how to learn from mistakes, and how proper reflection

and perseverance can bring out a more favorable outcome.

Students will have spelling words as well as vocabulary words on a weekly basis. This week we are focusing on high frequency words that fifth graders need to know how to spell. The content vocabulary will be discussed heavily in it's respective content area and the general vocabulary will be focused on during our reading workshop.

BEHAVIOR LOG

Every Friday students will bring home a behavior log. Students start with earning 15 fish cash a week. I will record exceptional behaviors as well as behavior concerns on this behavior log. Student will earn additional fish cash for the exceptional behaviors and will be fined fish cash for clipping down on our behavior chart, failing to turn homework in, or not following school or classroom expectations. In order for the students to receive the fish cash students need to return the signed behavior log the following Monday.
